Internship and Student Employment Program: WGLT offers employment and internship opportunities to students at Illinois State University, with 6-12 hourly student employees at any given time, and 6-12 unpaid, for-credit student internships per semester. Individuals are recruited through contact with Illinois State University's School of Communications, its student newspaper (The Daily Vidette), student radio station (WZND), and student television station (TV-10). Of student employees hired during the period covered by this report, three of the eight were female, and two were African-American.

Hosting of Job Fair: WGLT participates in Communication Week activities in April, an extracurricular job preparation program presented by the University's School of Communication and also participates by hosting an informational table in the annual "Festival ISU", which serves as a way to introduce students to various student and campus organizations with employment and volunteer opportunities. The WGLT market population is fewer than 250,000, and the station is therefore required to perform 2 outreach activities every 2 years.
